PROVIDENCE, RI – The Art League of Rhode Island (ALRI), will hold its annual members' exhibition in a return visit (2004) to the Attleboro Art Museum. The exhibit will run from **Wednesday, September 23 through October 16, 2009. An opening reception is scheduled for Friday, September 25 from 7 - 9 p.m.**

The exhibit will feature over 60 pieces in a variety of media including oil, watercolor, glass, photography, collagraph, encaustic, and mixed media created by over 50 Rhode Island artists.

“This return visit to the Attleboro Arts Museum is a tribute to the wonderful resource that Rhode Islander's are so fortunate to have just over our state line,” said ALRI President Iona Dobbins.

Like the Attleboro Art Museum, ALRI strives to provide professional guidance, exhibition venues, and opportunities for arts education to an ever-widening and diverse circle of artist members and patrons. A juried membership process recognizes high standards of artistic excellence.

Complementing the exhibit, scheduled gallery talks include: Hope Alswang, director of the RISD Museum, Sunday, September 26, 2pm; Exhibiting Artist Panel: *Perspectives on the Creative Process*, Sunday, October 10, 2pm. The Attleboro Arts Museum is located at 86 Park Street, Attleboro, Mass. Hours of operation are Tuesday - Saturday, 10 am - 5 pm.
